



This guide will provide the basics on navigating the platform, what features to look out for and provide you with some resources/tips to make your mentoring experience even better!


Signup Process


You will have received a link to register to your mentoring program. Upon clicking this link, you'll be directed to a signup page that will ask you to complete some questions. These cover aspects about you, your career, and most importantly, what you hope to contribute or achieve through your mentoring experience.

Once completed, your sign up form becomes your profile in the program, giving potential mentoring connections a glimpse into who you are. We recommend you <u>update</u> <u>your profile</u> and keep it up to date - as it helps others get to know you better and also plays a role in the matching process.

For some programs, the Program Coordinator may need to approve your application. Just wait for the confirmation email. If you don't receive it, reach out to your Program Coordinator.







Integrations

We aim to complement the natural and organic mentoring that may already be happening.

That's why we offer the flexibility to <u>integrate systems</u> you're already familiar with into the platform for a seamless transition into your day-to-day activities. Simply check your <u>account settings</u> to connect integrations.

















Your Dashboard

Once you've successfully joined the program, you'll have access to your <u>Mentorloop Dashboard</u>. It has been designed so that you can access all your mentoring needs in one place and support you in every step of your journey. You will find:



Loop-based Milestones

Once you have been found your mentoring match, the Mentorloop Milestones are a series of stages that will guide you through your mentoring relationship. The milestones automatically moves you along depending on the interactions you have with your match.

This is great for those who have never been in a mentoring relationship and are unsure of where to start.








Your program coordinators can customise this based on your role and can provide additional information that is more specific to your program.






Mentorloop Help Hub

Matching----

Manual or Algorithm Match

Based on your program, your Program Coordinator may have already assigned you a match, either *manually* or through the Mentorloop Algorithm.

What is the Algorithm?

It takes into account factors such as your skills, experience, location etc. If this is the case, you will receive an email notification regarding your match.

We recommend reaching out to your match to say hello and kick off your mentoring relationship!

Self Match

Alternatively, you may have the option of finding your own match within the program. You can explore potential matches via the left sidebar of Mentorloop under Flnd a Match and request to connect.



You will also be able to view some <u>Recommended matches</u> from your dashboard. These are the participants that Mentorloop has identified as being a great possible match for you.

Match Requests

Once you have found a great mentoring match you can request to *Connect* with them. <u>Here</u> are some tips on requesting your mentoring match.

Keep an eye on your notifications for match requests from other participants on the program, and be responsive!

Communication

Your Coordinator Loop

If you have a question that is related to the particular management of your mentoring program, it's probably best suited to your Program Coordinator.

You have direct access to your Program Coordinator/s via your 1:1 loop, which you can access by clicking "Your Coordinator" from the left navigation bar of your dashboard

1:1 Loop

Once you are matched, you will have access to a 1:1 Loop with your mentor/mentee.

A Loop is essentially a journal of your mentoring relationship, from where you can communicate with your match, <u>schedule meetings</u>, <u>launch Zoom calls</u>, <u>share files</u> and <u>set goals</u>.


Over time, the Loop becomes an online journal of your mentoring experience, so be sure to keep a record of your mentoring meetings in there!

Your 1:1 loop is confidential. You can also <u>close your</u> <u>mentoring relationship from the 1:1 Loop.</u>

Mentoring Agreement

We recommend setting expectations early on in your mentoring relationship. This adds structure and allows both the mentor and mentee to have a clear understanding of how your mentoring relationship will work.

The <u>mentoring agreement</u> will help you outline your mentoring expectations and set you up for success.

Support ----

Nudges and notifications

As you begin your mentoring journey, Mentorloop will send communications throughout the first six months of your journey, followed by monthly communications.

These messages will be filled with valuable tips and tricks to keep the momentum going in your relationship.

Expect updates on new features, suggested articles to read and share with your mentoring match, as well as discussion points to enrich your mentoring meetings!

We recommend keeping an eye out for messages from your mentor, mentee or Program Coordinator.

Notifications are sent to your email if you are not logged into Mentorloop.

Feedback surveys

To provide participants with even more support, Mentorloop occasionally sends through a survey. We encourage you to share your feedback by completing survey, as it provides real time insights to your Program Coordinator.

This enables them to offer you additional support tailored to your needs. The survey includes:

- Mentoring Quality Score: Sent every 60 days to gather feedback on your mentoring experience as it progresses
- 2. **Post-Meeting Survey:** Automatically sent if a meeting has been scheduled within the platform, capturing insights and reflections after each session
- 3. Close Loop Survey: <u>Triggered when a mentoring connection is closed</u>, either by you or your Program Coordinator.

Your input is invaluable in ensuring the effectiveness of the program and overall experience!
